VOTER INFORMATION

As a **REGISTERED VOTER**, you help make laws and select candidates and officials.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE: If you are a U.S. citizen, 18 years old by the day of the next election, and are a resident of Washington State, you may register to vote. To be eligible to vote in an election, you must have been registered for at least 30 days before that election.

WHERE TO REGISTER: Applications are available at the County Auditor's office, at any city hall, library, motor vehicle office, public school and many state agencies. Call the Auditor's office at (360) 337-7128 if you have trouble finding an application, or you may download the Voter Registration Form or register online at www.secstate.wa.gov.

RE-REGISTER IF YOU: Move or change your name.

WHERE TO VOTE: Kitsap County is now an entirely vote-by-mail county. Approximately three weeks prior to each election, all registered voters will receive a ballot in the mail. After marking the ballot, the voter must enclose it in the secrecy envelope and then in the outer mailing envelope, which must be signed and dated by the voter before it is sealed. The envelope must be stamped and postmarked on or before Election Day. There will also be one drop-box location in each area of the county for those who wish to deposit their ballots directly rather than mailing them.

ABSENTEE BALLOT: If you will be away from home during the election season, you may contact the office of the County Auditor up to 45 days before the election to request a ballot be mailed to you at an out-of-county address.

PRIMARY ELECTIONS are the first Tuesday in August.

GENERAL ELECTIONS are the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November. State ballot issues also are submitted for vote at this time. Federal, state, and county officials are elected in even years; city and district officials in odd years.

SPECIAL ELECTIONS may be held at other specified times.
