VOTER INFORMATION

As a **REGISTERED VOTER**, you help make laws and select candidates and officials.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE: If you are a U.S. citizen, 18 years old by the day of the next election, a resident of Washington State, and formerly incarcerated persons immediately upon release from prison, you may register to vote.

WHERE TO REGISTER: You may download the Voter Registration Form and mail it in or register online at www.VoteWA.gov 8 days prior to election day or when you renew your driver's license. You also may register in person before 8 p.m. on election day at the Auditor's office or one of the Vote Centers.

RE-REGISTER IF YOU: Move or change your name.

WHERE TO VOTE: Kitsap County is now an entirely vote-by-mail county. Approximately three weeks prior to each election, all registered voters will receive a ballot in the mail. After marking the ballot, the voter must enclose it in the secrecy envelope and then in the outer mailing envelope, which must be signed and dated by the voter. The envelope must be postmarked on or before Election Day or deposited in a county drop-box by 8 pm on election day.

ABSENTEE BALLOT: If you will be away from home during the election season, you may contact the office of the County Auditor up to 45 days before the election to request a ballot be mailed to you at an out-of-county address.

PRIMARY ELECTIONS are the first Tuesday in August.

GENERAL ELECTIONS are the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November. State ballot issues also are submitted for vote at this time. Federal, state, and county officials are elected in even years; city and district officials in odd years.

SPECIAL ELECTIONS may be held at other specified times.
